## **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Small Business Lend-

5 ing Fairness Act".

#### 6 SEC. 2. CREDIT TRANSACTIONS.

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 2 of the Truth in Lend8 ing Act (15 U.S.C. 1631 et seq.) is amended by adding
9 at the end the following:

## 1 "§ 140B. Unfair credit practices

"(a) IN GENERAL.—In connection with the extension 2 3 of credit in or affecting commerce, as defined in section 4 4 of the Federal Trade Commission Act (15 U.S.C. 44), 5 no creditor may directly or indirectly take or receive from 6 a borrower an obligation that constitutes or contains a 7 cognovit or confession of judgment (for purposes other 8 than executory process in the State of Louisiana), warrant 9 of attorney, or other waiver of the right to notice and the 10 opportunity to be heard in the event of suit or process thereon.". 11

(b) TECHNICAL AND CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—

140B".
